Potential Health Effects

Inhalation:

Short Term Exposure: Available data indicates that this product is not harmful.

Long Term Exposure: No data for health effects associated with long-term inhalation.

Skin Contact:

Short Term Exposure: Available data indicates that this product is not harmful. It should present no hazards in normal use. Product may be mildly irritating, but is unlikely to cause anything more than mild discomfort, which should disappear once contact ceases. Wash off with soapy water if discomfort occurs.

Long Term Exposure: No data for health effects associated with long-term skin exposure.

Eye Contact:

Section 4: First Aid Measures

General Information:

Section 10: Stability and Reactivity

Reactivity: This product is unlikely to react or decompose under normal storage conditions and will remain stable under normal conditions of use. However, if you have any doubts, contact the supplier. Shelf life for this product is 12 months or 12 months after opening.

Conditions to Avoid: This product should be kept in a cool place, preferably below 24°C. Oxidation will occur if the product is not correctly sealed.

Incompatibilities: No particular incompatibilities

Fire Decomposition: Only small quantities of decomposition products are expected from this product at temperatures normally achieved in a fire.

Hazardous Polymerisation: Will not occur

Minimum durability before opening: 24 months

Section 11: Toxicological Information

No tested data exists but the nature and concentration of the components suggest that no acute toxic effects are to be expected when used according to directions for topical application.

Local Effects: Essentially no irritating to skin, and only irritating to eyes when applied directly.

Sensitization: Essentially not a potential sensitizer on ingredient assessment.

Classification of Hazardous Ingredients: According to current information, when handled and stored correctly no effects damaging to one's health occur. Labelling is not required according to the latest EEC regulations.
